Friends of Centurion Way are a community group working to save this wonderful path and its artwork from decay and decline. Having saved the southern section from development and diversion, our plans are ambitious: to restore and reinstate the wonderful Gateway Arch over the start of the path – rebuilding its original structure in galvanised steel to ensure a long life and restore this meeting point.

Artwork is never cheap and the arch needs to be safe. We have received generous grants (specifically for community/artwork) but we unexpectedly have to use a West Sussex County Council contractor for the reinstallation/ foundations, which is expensive. We would also love to fund two information boards explaining the history of the arch and the art along the trail – one at the arch and one at the amphitheatre near the other sculptures.

If everyone who enjoys the path and its artwork gave us a small donation, we would easily smash our target. Let's do this together!
